DESIGNATION	IGP Pays d'Oc
CUVÉE	BLANC 2018
TERROIR	Limestone plateau with very stony soils. Terret comes from a vine planted in 1900 in complantation on a plateau with magnificent landscapes and which was doomed to uprooting.
VARIETIES	70 % Terret - 30 % Grenache Gris.
YELD	25 hl / ha
PRODUCTION	2550 Bottles
VINIFICATION - MATURING	<p>The harvest is manual and the grapes cooled before being pressed. Terret is a late variety well adapted to the poorest soils, very resistant to drought, we let it mature for a long time so that more complex aromas develop. The Grenache gris, harvested early, brings minerality and tension. Vinification and aging in 500 l barrels (Stockinger) for 9 months. Bottling took place in August 2019.</p>
TASTING	<p>The Terret associated with the more nervous Grenache, we get a balance between smoothness and mineral freshness. The woodiness is well integrated and the aromatic richness develops after aeration in the glass. With fish soup, Asian cuisine, as an aperitif.</p>
